

PARTICIPATE IN A STUDY ABOUT EATING DISORDERS.

The Eating Disorders Program at the Douglas Institute is conducting a study entitled: **A gene x environment/ epigenetic study in women with an Eating Disorder**

Researcher responsible for the project is: Howard Steiger, PhD, Director of the EDP and Professor in Psychiatry at McGill University.

We are hoping to recruit female participants, aged 18 to 40, who have once had full-blown Anorexia nervosa, but who are now recovered, in the sense of maintaining normal body weight and being free of symptoms like excessive calorie restriction, binge-eating or purging for at least one year.

The study requires participants to complete several interviews and questionnaires, and to provide a blood sample for epigenetic measurements. Participants will be reimbursed for time contributed to the study.
